#### **Cabins**


**Two Fox Cabins** is a complex of charming, small private cabins located on the small Cuchara River, two blocks from the workshop are recently remodeled.

#### **WORKSHOP QUALIFICATIONS**

To get the most from the workshop, please come already knowing basic camera operation: how shutter speeds relate to lens openings, what depth of field means, and what each dial or button on your camera does. Study your camera manual and bring it with you.

Please do not register for a workshop unless you are able to stay for the entire period, including our final dinner, as an early departure seriously disrupts the spirit and fellowship of the workshop.

#### **REGISTRATION**

The workshop is limited to 10 students. The workshop tuition is \$950. A \$500 deposit is required to reserve your place in the workshop. The balance is due on or before July 1, 2016. You will be contacted when it is time to submit your final payment.

#### **CANCELLATIONS**

For cancellations prior to June 1, 2016, you will be refunded 80% of your \$500 deposit. No refunds will be issued after June 1, 2016.
